Background

Division for Conservation of Heritage Sites (DCHS) under Department of Culture, MoHCA has scheduled to begin extensive surveys of heritage sites in all 20 Dzongkhags from this fiscal year and to be continued in the next fiscal year. Inventory is very important for the office to keep records and will be used for the registration of Heritage Sites. It will also be very useful when scrutinising the proposals from the Dzongkhags and greatly useful for making management plan for the important heritage sites.

Job Title and Responsibilities

The individual selected will function as architect who will be mainly responsible to carry out the followings:

- 1. Collection History and information about the heritage sites
- 2. Surveying GPS coordinates
- 3. Documentations; photographs, drawings (plan, section and elevation)
- 4. Determining the Heritage Value of each sites (will be assisted and guided by the office)
- 5. Compilation data collected and format the data for easy reference and use

DCHS office will brief and train individuals for the above mentioned works. The works will not be limited to the above mentioned (serial 1-5) works.

Job Type and Duration

Architects will be hired on contract basis for 2 months in the fiscal year 2017-2018. Since the inventory work will be continued to 2018-2019 fiscal year, the extension of contract duration will carried out based on the performance of the individual and the availability of budget. The DCHS office will guide and monitor the work.

Location/ Work of Place

- Each hired architects will carry out the surveys of heritages in two Dzongkhags.
- Selected candidates will also be deployed to Punakha Dzongkhag accompanied to DCHS officials for the preparation of Management Plan (priority)
- The selected candidates will not just be restricted to Punakha Dzongkhag
